COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course reflects the role of barbers who use a range of well-developed sales, consultation and technical skills and knowledge to provide a broad range of barbering services to clients. They use discretion and judgement to provide client services and take responsibility for the outcomes of their own work. This qualification provides a pathway to work as a barber in any industry environment, usually a barber shop or a salon.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students will need to demonstrate the Learning, Literacy and Numeracy skills required for this course prior to course commencement.

STUDENT CLINIC

SCA operates a student run clinic day designed to enable students to gain valuable experience and skills for treating clients in a hair salon environment. Students are supervised by an educator and perform treatments in which they have been deemed competent in.
